

Adam Maciejczyk MD PhD habilitatus is an oncologist and a specialist in radiation oncology. He specialises in paediatric neoplasms.

Director of Lower Silesia Cancer Centre in Wrocław. Chairman of the National Association of Public Cancer Centres and Institutes. Member of the Scientific Council of the Maria Skłodowska Curie Memorial Cancer Centre and Institute of Oncology. Academic teacher at the Medical University in Wrocław. In October 2016, he was appointed to the position of the President-elect of the Polish Cancer Society.

He had clinical practice in Gustave Roussy Institute in Paris (2003) and attended clinical and scientific internship at MD Anderson Cancer Centre in Houston, USA (2006). He is a member of the European Society for Therapeutic Radiology and Oncology (ESTRO) and Pediatric Radiation Oncology Society (PROS).

He performs the function of reference radiotherapist for Poland in respect of soft tissue sarcoma treatment in children and he is a member of the General Council of the Polish Society of Radiation Oncology (PSRO) and coordinator of the Paediatric Radiotherapy Section of the Polish Paediatric Solid Tumours Group.
